HYC Laser Frostbite Mission Statement



HYC frostbiting aims to offer great racing and friendly competition during the winter, from November through March. Our priority is to keep our sailors, mark boat drivers, and the Race Committee safe. The PRO has the final authority to decide whether racing will occur on a given day.

Our goal is to promote fair and rule-abiding sailing and to provide a platform for training and developing racing skills at all levels. Sailors are encouraged to sail clean and fast. Aggressive and risky sailing is discouraged because of the cold temperatures, which often aggravate an errant maneuver. Any bullying towards the RC, mark boats, or fellow sailors is unacceptable. Anyone failing to observe Rule 2 - FAIR SAILING or Rule 69 - MISCONDUCT will not be scored for the day.

RRS RULE 2: FAIR SAILING

A boat and her owner shall compete in compliance with recognized principles of sportsmanship and fair play. A boat may be penalized under this rule only if it is clearly established that these principles have been violated. The penalty shall be a disqualification that is not excludable.

RRS RULE 69 MISCONDUCT

69.1 Obligation not to Commit Misconduct; Resolution

- (a) A competitor, boat owner or support person shall not commit an act of misconduct.
- (b) Misconduct is:
 - (1) *conduct that is a breach of good manners, a breach of good sportsmanship, or unethical behavior; or*
 - (2) *conduct that may bring, or has brought, the sport into disrepute.*
- (c) An allegation of a breach of rule 69.1(a) shall be resolved in accordance with the provisions of rule 69. It shall not be grounds for a protest and rule 63.1 does not apply.
