- C. Change to SI 7.1: Courses will be announced verbally from RC boat or dock.
- D. Change to SI 7.2: The Course will be around docks, drop marks and government buoys determined by wind direction and geography.
- E. Change to SI 9.1: Races will be started using 2 minute audible starting sequence.
